DECLARATION OF MANUEL J. DOMINGUEZ

I, Manuel J. Dominguez, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a partner with the law firm of Cohen Milstein Sellers & Toll, PLLC ("Cohen Milstein"). I respectfully submit this declaration in support of Interim Co-Lead Class Counsel's Motion for Award of Attorneys' Fees and Reimbursement of Litigation Expenses in connection with services rendered in the above-captioned action ("Action").

2. The statements herein are true to the best of my personal knowledge, information and belief based on the books and records of Cohen Milstein and information received from its attorneys and staff. Cohen Milstein's time and expense records are prepared and maintained by the firm in the ordinary course of business.

3. This firm is counsel for Laurence Hughes who serves as a Representative Plaintiff in this Action.

4. Cohen Milstein serves as additional Plaintiffs' counsel for the putative class in this Action. I am the partner who oversaw my firm's involvement in the Action. Cohen Milstein's time and expense records (including, where necessary, backup documentation) have been reviewed to

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confirm both the accuracy of the entries as well as the necessity for and reasonableness of the time and expenses expended in this litigation. As a result of this review, certain reductions were made to both time and expenses either in the exercise of billing judgment or to conform to the firm's agreement with Mr. Hughes, directions from Interim Co-Lead Counsel or my firm's practice. As a result of this review and related reductions, the time reflected in Cohen Milstein's lodestar calculation and the expenses for which payment is sought are reasonable in amount and were necessary to prosecute the Action and resolve the settlement before the Court. In addition, these expenses are often charged by Cohen Milstein to its fee-paying clients.

5. During the course of this litigation, and as detailed herein, Cohen Milstein worked on assignments that it was specifically directed to perform by Interim Co-Lead Class Counsel Lowey Dannenberg, P.C. and Grant & Eisenhofer P.A. ("Interim Co-Lead Class Counsel").

6. Set forth below in ¶ 8 is a summary reflecting the amount of time (after any applicable reductions) Cohen Milstein attorneys and professional staff worked on the Action from the inception of the case in 2014 to October 31, 2020 and the corresponding lodestar value of that work. The schedule in ¶ 8 was prepared based upon daily time records maintained by attorneys and professional support staff at Cohen Milstein, and the lodestar calculations are based on the firm's current hourly billing rates. One of the attorneys in the schedule in ¶ 8, Emmy Levens, worked on this case when she was an associate and later when she became a partner and that is why she appears twice in the schedule with different hourly rates.

7. The services Cohen Milstein performed on behalf of the putative class include, but are not limited to, the following:

- investigated the case;
- interviewed potential witnesses;
- worked with experts;

- drafted complaint and motions; reviewed documents produced by defendants; and
- worked with client to produce documents responsive to discovery requests.

A breakdown of Cohen Milstein's hours by month is attached as Exhibit A.

8. Cohen Milstein's total fee compensable time for which it seeks an award of

attorneys' fees is summarized below.

9. The total time for which my firm is requesting an award of legal fees is 2,673.25

hours. The total lodestar value of these professional services is \$872,886.25.

10. The above hourly rates for Cohen Milstein's attorneys and professional support

staff are the firm's current hourly rates. The hourly rates for attorneys and professional support staff

in my firm are the same as the regular rates charged for their services in contingent fee matters and

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non-contingent fee matters. Timekeepers with less than 15 hours were excluded. For personnel no longer employed by Cohen Milstein, the lodestar calculation is based on the billing rates for such personnel in his or her final year of employment. Time spent preparing the fee and expense application was also excluded.

11. The firm's lodestar figures do not include charges for expense items. Expense items are billed separately, and such charges are not duplicated in the firm's current billing rates. Further, expense items do not contain any general overhead costs and do not contain a surcharge over the amount paid to the corresponding vendor(s).

12. As detailed and categorized in the below schedule, Cohen Milstein has incurred a total of \$48,149.88 in expenses from inception through October 31, 2020 for which it seeks to be reimbursed from the Settlement Fund.

The expense total above does not include the contributions Cohen Milstein made to the litigation fund established by Interim Co-Lead Counsel to fund various litigation expenses. As instructed by Interim Co-Lead Counsel, charges for in-house photocopying were capped at \$0.10 and all air travel was limited to coach class seats. Meal expenses were capped at \$50-\$75 per day for lunch and dinner and permitted only when traveling. The expert expenses relate to our retention of an economic expert to assist us in the investigation of this matter and the drafting of the complaint. The experts analyzed the silver market and provided economic and financial evidence of the existence of the silver manipulation and its effect on the market and its participants. Various portions of their analysis are used in the current operative complaint.

14. The above schedule was prepared based upon expense records reflected in the books and records of Cohen Milstein. These books and records are prepared from expense vouchers, check records, receipts and other source materials.
